BURNING PERMIT

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This permit is issued subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Permit issued to a competent adult.
- 2. Prior to commencement of open burning, the fire department shall be notified.
- 3. Open burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any structure or other combustible material. Conditions which could cause the fire to spread to 50 feet of any structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition. EXCEPTION: Clearance from structures and other combustible materials is allowed to be reduced as follows;
 - A. Not less than 15 feet when burning is conducted in an approve burning appliance.
 - B. Not less than 25 feet when the pile size is 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.
- 4. A garden hose connected to a water supply or other approved fire extinguishing equipment shall be readily available for use at the open burning site.
- 5. Burning material shall be constantly attended by a person knowledgeable in the use of the fire extinguishing equipment required and familiar with the permit limitations which restrict open burning. An attendant shall supervise the burning material until the fire has been extinguished.
- 6. The fire department is authorized to require that the open burning be immediately discontinued if the fire department determines that the smoke emissions are offensive to occupants of surrounding property or if the open burning is determined by the fire department to constitute a hazardous condition.
- 7. Burning activities shall be conducted between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. only.

This permit shall be revoked when the following items or materials used for/in the burning process:

- 1. Flammable or combustible liquids.
- 2. Hazardous and chemical materials.

3. Garbage, dead animals, rubber and other materials which produces unreasonable amount of air contaminants, which may be detrimental to health and/or may contaminate the environment.

All burning requires personal attention. This permit does not relieve the applicant or any other person from liability for damages done to life or property due to burning pursuant to this permit. The Guam Fire Department or the Government of Guam by reason of any inspection or approval of premises of issuance of this permit assumes no liability. The violation of any of the above conditions shall render this permit null and void, and subjects the holder to the penalty set forth in Title X, Chapter 3 of the GCA, Chapter 6 of the Guam Air Pollution Control Regulation and the Uniform Fire Code.
